1. TMS system introduction

Welcome to the WCC Transportation Management System (TMS).

The TMS system allows users to obtain real-time and historical data pertaining to their children's ridership on buses. Users can search for the location of the bus in real time, review historical data from the past week, as well as receive up to date communications from the transportation office In TMS, you can look for the line number of the bus that your child is riding, get the real-time position of the bus, look for his or her riding history within the past a week, and also can receive messages from the Transportation Office. All the data collected is based on the student who is swiping the card when he or she gets on and off of the bus.

2. TMS system installation

If not, please turn to Settings -> Cellular -> Select WCC TMS -> Select WLAN & Cellular Data. (see Figure 2 and 3)

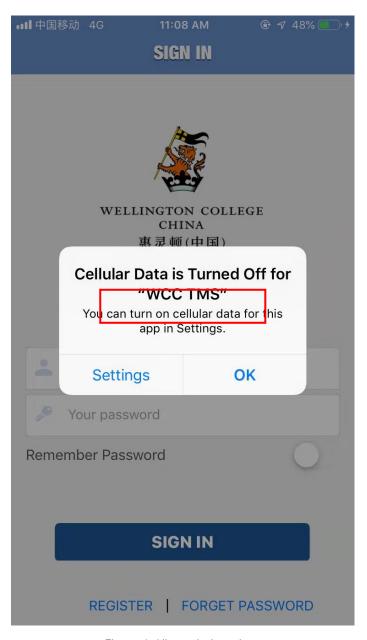


Figure 1 Allow wireless data

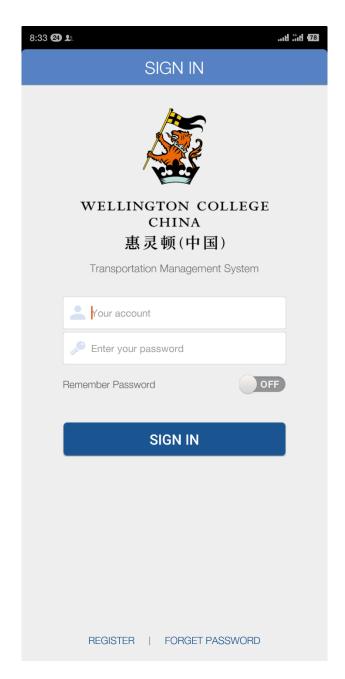


Figure 2 Select WLAN & Cellular Data

3. TMS app Introduction

3.1 Login

From the login page, you need to enter account and password. The first users need to SIGN UP. If forget your password, click the FORGET PASSWORD. Both register and reset are at the bottom.



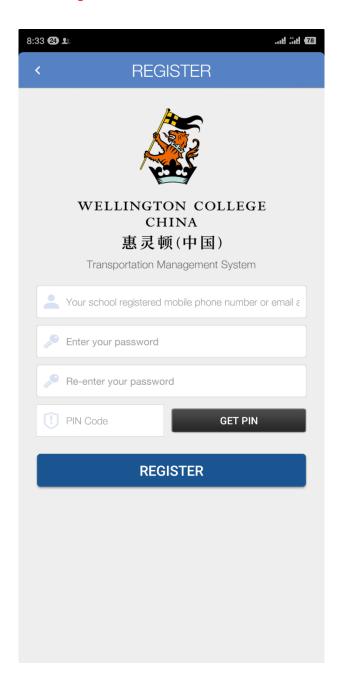


Figure 3 Sign in Figure 4 Register

NOTE: Signup by email or mobile number of Mainland China registered at school's system, or a message will pop-up:" Neither email nor phone number you entered exists. Please confirm the email or number is in school's system".

3.2 Monitoring

This feature allows you to view, in real time, the latest status of your child or children on the bus. If your child or children are not on the bus, it will show the location of the latest swiping card of today. Once your child or children have gotten "on" or "off" the bus you can check this status from the history page.

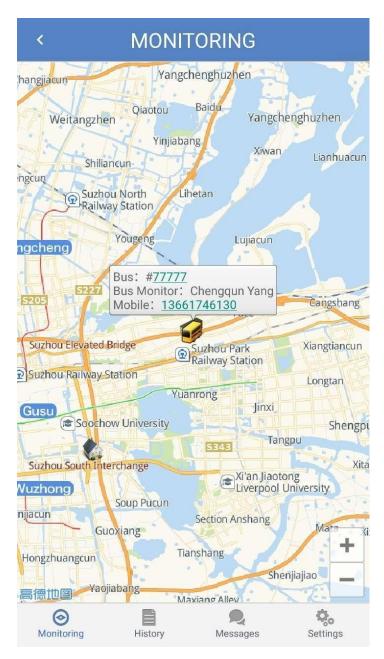


Figure 6 Monitoring one child

Click the button at the up right corner, then click the "NO BUS", select the date in which you don't need a bus.

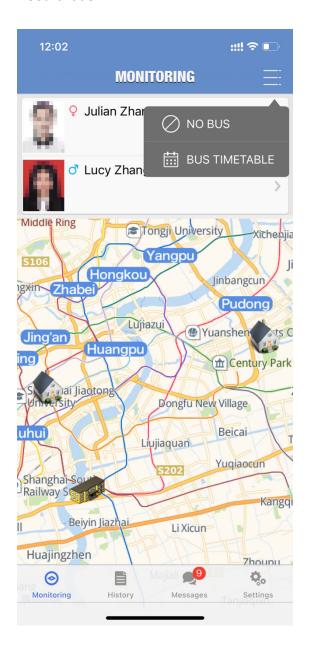
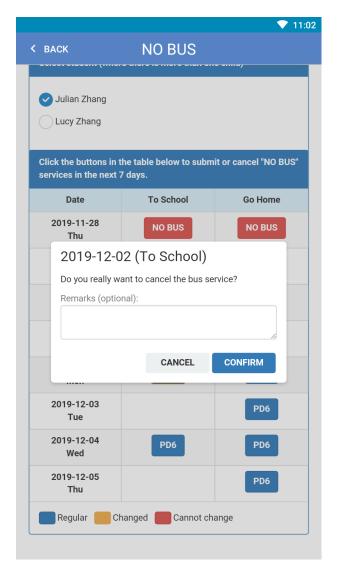




Fig 7 Monitoring Page

You can apply or cancel the NOBUS by click the day you want to apply



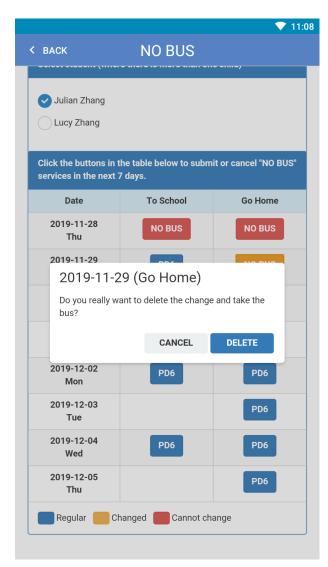
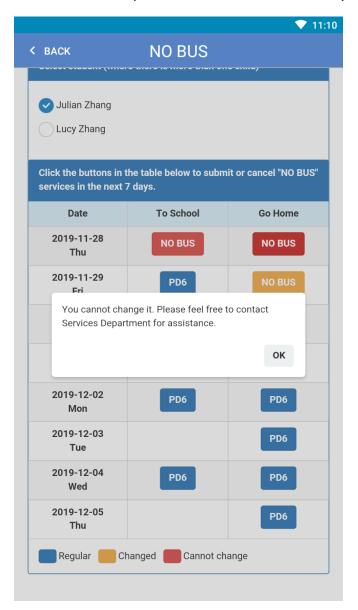


Figure 9 Confirm No Bus

If you want to change "NO BUS" of current day after 13:00, another will popup: "NO BUS" service option this afternoon is only available before 13:00.



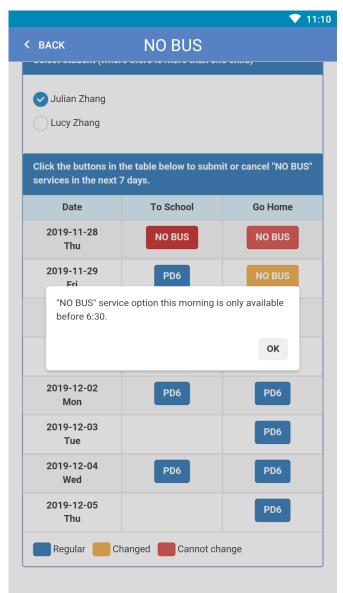


Figure 11 Cannot change

3.3 History

The history page allows you to review the recorded data for your child or children for the past seven days.

3.4 Message

You can review transportation office messages from the Messages page.

You will also receive messages when your children are swiped on Ayi's app.

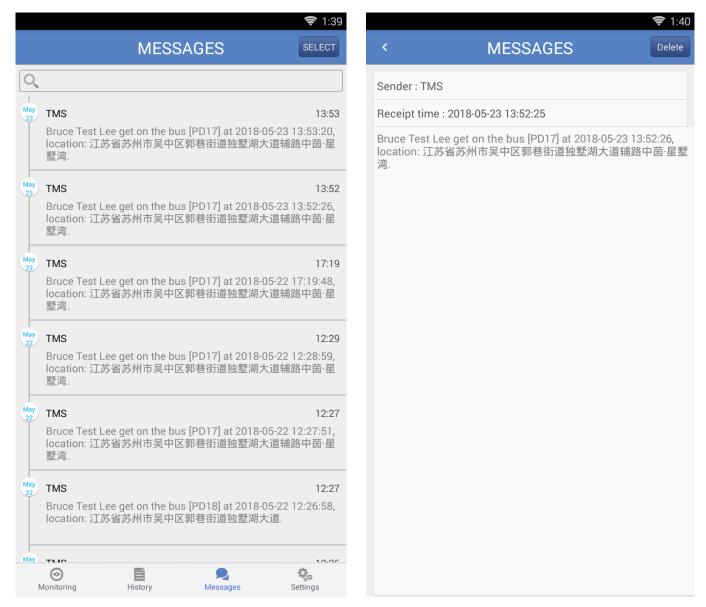


Figure 14 Messages List

3.5 Settings

On the settings page, you can look up your children's information, turn on/off the messaging function, check and update the software version, change the system default language.

In the Student Information page, you can get Bus Monitor's phone number, and the compound name, stop name, and pictures of the stop, so that parents are able to figure out where the stop exactly is.

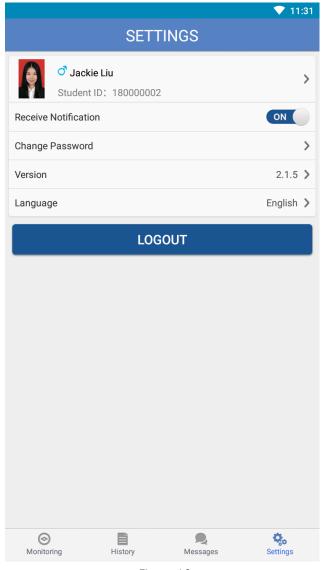

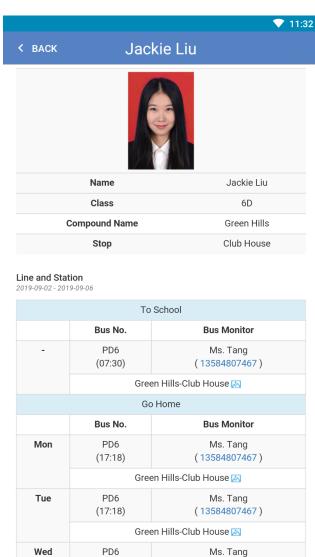
